## 1. How we protect your personal data

- 1. We will not transfer your personal data outside of the EU without your consent
- 2. We have implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security in order to protect personal data from loss, misuse, or unauthorized alteration or destruction. We will notify you

promptly in the event of any breach of your personal data which might expose you to serious risk. We have a clearly defined contract in place with our Data Processor which sets the requirements they are to meet.

- 3. Members are asked to note that where they are transmitting information to the club over the internet this can never be guaranteed to be 100% secure.
- 4. We will notify you promptly in the event of any breach of your personal data which might expose you to serious risk.

### 2. Who else has access to the information you provide to us?

1. We will never sell your personal data. We will not share your personal data with any 3<sup>rd</sup> parties without your prior consent (which you are free to withhold) except where to do so by law

#### 3. How long do we keep your information?

- 1. We will hold your personal data on our systems for as long as you are a member of the club and for as long afterwards as is necessary to comply with our legal obligations. We will review your personal data every year to establish whether we are still entitled to process it. If we decide that we are not entitled to do so we will stop processing your personal data except that we will retain it in an archived form to be able to comply with future legal obligations and the establishment exercise or defence of claims.
- 2. We securely destroy all financial information once we have used it and no longer need it.

#### 4. Your rights

- 1. You have rights under the GDPR:
  - 1. To access your data
  - 2. To be provided with information about how your personal data is processed
  - 3. To have your personal data corrected
  - 4. To have your personal data erased in certain circumstances
  - 5. To object to or restrict how your personal data is processed
  - 6. To have your personal data transferred to yourself or to another business in certain circumstances
